

SAFE RETURN TO IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION AND CONTINUITY OF SERVICES PLAN

Effective for the 2022-2023 school year, Plainview ISD is following State and local health official safety recommendations. All learning will take place face-to-face. If a student is exposed or tests positive for COVID-19, they will follow quarantine procedures as recommended by the Superintendent.

Plainview ISD Frequently Asked Questions

1) Will Plainview ISD require students/staff to wear masks?

No, students and staff will not be required to wear as recommended by the state and local safety recommendations unless mandated by the Governor.

2) Will Plainview ISD be modifying facilities to allow for physical distancing?

No, but if there is another strain/occurrence affecting our students and staff then the district will.

3) Will Plainview ISD provide hand washing and respiratory etiquette?

Yes, Plainview ISD will continue to provide student and staff handwashing and respiratory etiquette.

4) Will Plainview ISD be cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities including ventilation?

Yes. In addition, Plainview ISD has purchased air purifiers district wide.

5) Will Plainview ISD contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine, in collaboration with the state, local, territorial, or tribal health departments?

No. Plainview ISD will follow the local guidelines from our local health department.

6) Will Plainview ISD screen district staff and students?

No.

7) Will Plainview ISD put effort to provide vaccinations to school communities?

No. Plainview ISD will provide external sources for vaccine administering sites.
