- I. Welcome – Edna welcomes committee and introduces Dr. Richburg as director of technology
- II. Technology in District – Dr. Brent Richburg
 - a. Mentioned the purchase of chromebooks for the district that used with CFR funds and federal funds. Dr. Richburg presented a video that shows how chromebooks and interactive panels were set up and distributed around the district. Panels will roll out by the end of the month. Great for smaller grades for hands on activity. Another video was also presented to the group. Goal is in 2 years for every classroom to have interactive panels instead of projectors.
 - b. Mrs. Garcia mentions the excitement teachers and students get when they receive the interactive panels. It's been a great resource for instructional lessons.
 - c. Robert Nava – asks if Wifi and Hotspots been upgrade to ensure no one is struggling with Chromebooks and interactive

panels. Dr. Richburg says that WiFi has been updated and no major complaints have been made.

- d. John Bertsch – how long does it take for tech team to distribute/set up. Dr. Richburg said that for \$6 a unit a company will come in to set up and wire panels/chromebook to save time. About 3 hours/campus
- e. Christina Jones – are CB replacing computers or just an addon. She also mentions that her son has had issues with using slow technology. Dr. Richburg said the process will take about 2-3 years to catch up and have all students have updated technology. This goal comes from the transition of online testing.
- f. 2022-2023 will be online for state assessment – Salazar
- g. About 1M was spent on technology
