

STUDENT AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

(REGULATION)

MERIT "P" AWARDS

Merit "P" certificates will be furnished by the school for the purpose of recognizing outstanding achievement. Eligibility for an award shall be defined as follows:

ELEMENTARY  
GRADES 1-5

Students in grades 1-5 who have maintained a 90 or above average in each subject area for the first five six-week reporting periods shall be eligible.

Students in any grade who have a perfect attendance record for the school year beginning with the first day of school (having been neither absent, tardy nor left school early for any reason) shall be eligible

Students who achieve recognition or demonstrate outstanding achievement for which the principal may wish to present an award (with the approval of the Superintendent.) shall be eligible.

SECONDARY  
GRADES 6-12

Students in grades 6-12 who have perfect attendance (having been absent, tardy, nor left school early for any reason) shall be eligible.

Students who are on the " Honor Roll "for the first semester and second semester (4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> six-week reporting periods) in a school year shall be eligible.

Students who receive an honor on or beyond the District level or students who receive an award that reflects honor to the student and the school shall be eligible.

Students who have earned other special recognition deemed outstanding by the principal and approved by the Superintendent shall be eligible.

SUPERINTENDENT  
CITATION

The student with the highest grade in an individual class will be eligible for the Superintendent Citation
